Accepting applications for call & per-diem FF/EMT's

**The Ashby Fire Department is seeking call & Per-diem EMT and FF/EMT's to fill
varying daytime per-diem shifts Monday - Sunday.**

Job Description:

Under general supervision of a fire officer, senior EMS personnel, or acting officer, a call / per-diem Firefighter/EMT performs emergency medical transportation, firefighting and administrative duties as assigned. The FF/EMT renders emergency first aid and medical treatment at the minimum level of the Massachusetts EMT-Basic, answers the phone and forwards calls to the appropriate personnel or mailbox, interacts with the public, answers questions within their ability, performs housekeeping, restocking and other tasks within the ambulance and station, performs daily checks and maintains all fire department equipment and performs related work as required within the scope of their training and abilities.

- ❖ Per-Diem EMT's and FF/EMT's have the ability to pick up 10Hr per-diem shifts that are generally available Monday through Sunday on an as-needed basis 7AM - 5PM.
- ❖ EMT's living within 8 min of the station may also pick up overnight "On Call Shifts" and are paid a stipend to respond to all medical incidents within the 12 Hr overnight period.
- ❖ Continuing Education will be provided, M&M Rounds, Online LMS, in person classes & NCCR.

Minimum qualifications:

- Current MA EMT Basic, AEMT, or Paramedic or Nationally registered with ability to obtain a minimum of an Massachusetts EMT-Basic prior to starting. (Must maintain certification in good standing)
- Two years of relevant work experience.
- Current BLS CPR Certification (AHA preferred).
- Ability to work flexible, varying shifts, independently and within a team.
- Live within the town of Ashby or a bordering community.
- Submit to and pass a CORI check.
- High School Diploma or Equivalent.

Preferred qualifications:

- Pro Board FireFighter I / II Certification.
- EMTs with over two years experience, AEMT's or Paramedic's.
- Lives within the town of Ashby.
- Ability to produce up to date EMS continuing education records including classes such as Blood Borne Pathogens, HIPAA, Stretcher, MOLST, Hazmat, paramedic basic interface, etc. (Training will be provided if unavailable.)

Hourly compensation is commensurate with certification level, preference will be given to those with FF I/II certification, or additional experience.
